

Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 Disclosure

This notice is provided in accordance with the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 (UIGEA) and Regulation GG.

The UIGEA prohibits any person engaged in the business of betting or wagering from knowingly accepting payments in connection with the participation of another person in unlawful internet gambling. As defined by Regulation GG, unlawful internet gambling means- to place, receive, or otherwise knowingly transmit a bet or wager by any means which involves the use, at least in part, of the internet where such bet or wager is unlawful under any Federal or State law in the State in which the bet is made.

As a business member, these restricted transactions are prohibited from being processed through your account. Members 1st reserves the right to close your account if you engage in an internet gambling business, as well as block or reject any suspected restricted transaction(s).
